- On Nov. 16, a wrap-up party for the fourth annual Pink Ribbon Golf Classic was held at Underwood Jewelers to present checks to Mayo Clinic Jacksonville and Baptist Medical Center-Beaches. As event Chairwoman Robin Wahby and Honorary Chairwoman Tabitha Furyk hoped, the tournament that raises money for breast cancer research and care netted about \$100,000. It also was the night a raffle ticket was drawn for the John Hardy designer bracelet that Underwood donated to the event. Lucky winner Gleith Mann wasn't on hand to collect her prize, but Baptist Development Director Kerrie Slattery and Edith Perez, Mayo's breast cancer program director, were there to each receive a check for about \$53,000.

"The gift is astounding," Slattery said. "Baptist Medical Center-Beaches will use the money to enhance women's breast cancer services, and we're going to name our private mammography waiting area for the Pink Ribbon Classic."
